SOS – Episode 18 – Model Man

INT. COFFEE SHACK - TABLES - MORNING

ALEX is sitting listening to NOAH's ipod, reading the paper with a coffee.

ALEX in unknowingly bobbing to the music.

SPEED FOOTAGE

Thousands of people walk past, infatuated with ALEX.

ALEX drinks his coffee, still focused on the newspaper.

A young girl (JESSY) prowls around the outskirts, eyeing off ALEX

Thousands more people pass and stare at ALEX

JESSY remains staring in one spot.

ALEX finishes the paper, then drains his coffee.

ALEX stands, head bopping to music.

JESSY encourages herself into springing.

JESSY Hey!

ALEX walks to music.

JESSY approaches ALEX from behind.

JESSY MATE!

JESSY reaches out to tap ALEX.

A PERSON on a chair stands knocking JESSY forward, into ALEX's back.

ALEX stands firm, JESSY collapses to the ground at his feet.

FADE TO:

OPENING CREDITS

FADE IN:

ALEX turns, looks down and pulls the earphones out.

ALEX Are you alright?

JESSY shakes it off.

JESSY Yeah, yeah.

ALEX looks behind her at the PERSON with the chair.

ALEX Are you going to apologise?

PERSON Sorry love, are you alright?

> JESSY Fine, fine.

ALEX extends a hand to her.

ALEX You sure, I think you're speaking double.

PERSON leaves.

JESSY Sorry about running into you.

> ALEX Not a problem.

JESSY I was trying to catch up to you.

ALEX Really?

JESSY Yeah, I called a couple of times. You were tuning, it's ok. ALEX Oh, yeah, I'm told I listen to loud.

JESSY I'm Jessy Cartwright, I was wondering if you would mind a job?

ALEX

What sort of job?

JESSY Modelling my clothes.

ALEX

Oh, um...

JESSY

It isn't what you think. I am a design major. The fashion festival in town has offered to let me parade one male and one female outfit. I am desperate.

ALEX

For me?

JESSY People stare at you. You're perfect.

ALEX

Thanks.

JESSY

It will only take an hour, and I can pay you. F, Five hundred dollars.

> ALEX You don't need to go over the top. Fifty bucks is fine.

JESSY No, the festival would pay you that.

ALEX

Oh, OK. What do I have to do?

JESSY

Walk along listening to music. You can even have your ipod.

ALEX

Oh, it isn't mine. JESSY That's ok. It is cat walk, thirty seconds.

ALEX

Ok

JESSY

Makeup and hair will take about an hour. Would you mind if we trim your hair?

ALEX

No.

JESSY Great. Great. This is great.

ALEX When?

JESSY

Tonight?

ALEX When?

JESSY

Six O'clock. In the CDB

ALEX Where do I have to be?

JESSY

The building is called Q one, it is the big tall one. The catwalk is out the front. Makeup is inside the function room. Here. JESSY hands ALEX an access pass.

ALEX

Thanks.

JESSY You can bring someone with you on that.

ALEX

Oh, ok.

JESSY If you can get there at five thirty?

ALEX Sure.

JESSY Great.

ALEX See you then.

JESSY Oh yeah, great, thanks. Bye.

ALEX turns and exits.

JESSY waits a moment, then jumps and screams in excitement.

CUT TO:

INT. ARC GYM – CARDIO ROOM – AFTERNOON.

NOAH and JEN are running on tredmills.

ALEX enters from behind

NOAH It isn't like they need to keep us all back that long.

ALEX get's onto the machine next to NOAH

JEN I think they like doing it.

NOAH

I'm sure they do.

ALEX starts running, JEN checks him out and realises who he is.

JEN Check out the talent next to you.

NOAH turns.

NOAH Alex!

NOAH smiles.

ALEX Guess what.

NOAH

No.

ALEX

Fine.

I just got offered five hundred bucks to walk around a stage for thirty seconds.

NOAH smiles

NOAH You're modelling? What for?

ALEX The fashion show tonight.

JEN No way! No one can get tickets to that!

ALEX holds up the pass.

ALEX (to NOAH) Be my date? NOAH Love to. Can't. Junior coaching.

ALEX Bugger.

NOAH Take Jen. She'll be the perfect accessory.

> ALEX But I want you to see it.

NOAH I get to see you walking quite a lot.

> ALEX But I'll be all dressed up.

NOAH I can try to get there after.

ALEX Good.

NOAH Take Jen though. Trip can get me in.

ALEX Great!

Gotta go.

ALEX stops the machine, dropping off the back.

ALEX Jen, be at my dorm at five.

JEN Yep.

ALEX Bye.

NOAH & JEN Bye

ALEX exits.

JEN He may be gay, but I still love watching him leave a room.

NOAH I prefer him talking showers.

JEN You suck!

FADE TO:

EXT. ALEX'S DORM – CARPARK – NIGHT

ALEX stands by his car waiting.

JEN runs toward him.

JEN is dressed up perfectly.

ALEX is in a track suit.

ALEX Hurry up!

It's quarter past.

JEN Sorry, I can't run in heals.

ALEX gets into the car.

JEN trots around and gets in.

JEN You got the pass?

ALEX Fuck!

ALEX gets out.

JEN And ipod!

FADE TO:

INT. FASHION SHOW – MAKE UP ROOM – NIGHT.

ALEX walks through in a track suit, everybody stares.

JESSY is standing behind a girl getting a hair cut.

ALEX walks over to her.

JEN follows him.

ALEX Hey.

JESSY turns.

JESSY HI. You made it.

ALEX Yeah.

This is Jen.

JESSY Oh. Hi Jen.

JEN

Hi.

ALEX She is a fashion freak.

JESSY Ahhh, well, you can take his pass now. Look around?

JEN Really? Great!

JESSY Alex goes up at eight.

ALEX Eight???

JESSY

Yep. Make up will take an hour and a half, then dressing...

> JEN Maybe Noah can see you after all.

> > ALEX (slumped) Yeah.

JESSY Noah?

ALEX Jones.

JESSY Oh. The gay rower?

ALEX (annoyed) Yep.

JEN (whispering to JESSY) He is the footballer boyfriend... Very protective.

JESSY shrinks.

JESSY Let's get started.

CUT TO:

ALEX is sitting in a barber's chair in a smock.

CUT TO:

ALEX surrounded by three women, dabbing on makeup.

CUT TO:

ALEX stands in the centre having clothing sewn onto him by JESSY.

ALEX's outfit is covered.

JESSY Sorry about that gay comment before.

ALEX That's fine.

JESSY I didn't know you knew Noah. I'm just used to the nickname.

> ALEX That's fine. Noah likes it, I don't.

JESSY It's gone then. (beat) DONE.

CUT TO:

EXT. Q1 - CATWALK - NIGHT

Lights are every where, People are crowded around the catwalk watching models appear walk and disappear.

Cameras flash everywhere.

EXT. Q1 – CATWALK BACKSTAGE – NIGHT

TRIP walks around, dressed models, checking out the fashion.

TRIP notices ALEX.

ALEX is in a dressing gown.

TRIP Alexander.

ALEX G'day

TRIP Who are you working for?

> ALEX A girl from school.

TRIP Miss Cartwright. You look excellent.

> ALEX Thanks. I'm packing it.

TRIP Noah is out front.

> ALEX Really?!

TRIP He is very bored.

ALEX laughs.

JESSY Alex! Two minutes, got the ipod?

ALEX holds up the ipod.

ALEX Bye Trip.

TRIP Best of luck.

TRIP exits.

ALEX exhales deeply.

JESSY

Ok, I don't want you worrying about anything. I want you to find a song you like. All you have to do is walk like you did in the coffee shop. (beat) Remember, more people were looking at you there then they are here.

ALEX looks at her quizzically then relaxes.

ALEX Right.

ALEX searches for a song.

ALEX finds one and tunes out.

JESSY looks at him, she is very excited.

JESSY ushers ALEX to the base of the stairs.

ALEX closes his eyes and beats his head to the tune.

CUT TO:

SONG – BLACK EYED PEAS – WHERE IS THE LOVE.

EXT. Q1 – CAT WALK – NIGHT

ALEX emerges.

ALEX is wearing a tuxido jacket, with cammo pants, and combat boots.

ALEX walks out with his ipod in hand, his is only acknowledging the music.

ALEX walks toward the end of the catwalk, cameras are going berserk.

ALEX stands at the end of the main catwalk, sweeps the crow, still listening.

ALEX scratches his shoulder, turns and leaves.

ALEX turns at the exit.

ALEX stops, sweeps the crowd again.

ALEX exits.

EXT. Q1 – CATWALK BACKSTAGE – NIGHT

ALEX walks down the exit steps.

JESSY Waits at the bottom.

JESSY grabs ALEX, hugging him.

JESSY YES!!!!! I knew you'd do it!!!

ALEX Do what?

JESSY Three people have asked me about you already!

ALEX laughs.

ALEX Where can I get changed? Noah is outside.

JESSY Keep it. Where it outside.

ALEX Ok. I'll just get my bag.

JESSY I'll get it for you. Go out.

ALEX turns for the exit.

JESSY watches him.

EXT. Q1 – CROWD – NIGHT

ALEX enters directly into a mass of press.

Many refocus their attention onto ALEX.

ALEX pushed through, searching.

ALEX finds NOAH across the way.

ALEX begins to force his way over.

ALEX eventually reaches NOAH.

NOAH sees ALEX, Hugs and Kisses him.

NOAH Schweet!

ALEX Yeah?

NOAH You walk good.

ALEX I never want to do that again.

> NOAH Fair enough.

ALEX How was training?

NOAH A fish jumped into a kids boat. He freaked out. It was good.

ALEX Do you want to get going?

NOAH I don't mind, I'm here now.

ALEX Jessy was just going to get me my bag.

NOAH Wow, Alex Williams letting someone wait on him.

ALEX No, nothing like that.

NOAH One day as a model!

ALEX

No way!

NOAH So long Kansas.

ALEX

Whatever.

NOAH

I am not kidding you. Trust me, your life began today. You will be on the front page tomorrow and signed by Friday.

ALEX

You think?

NOAH Jessy made a very big mistake.

ALEX

Don't say that.

NOAH She chose a model that out shone her clothes.

ALEX

Stop it.

NOAH

Modesty is boring. I'm not kidding you. I saw five runs, only three cameras went off in all of them.

> ALEX Holy shit.

JESSY arrives.

JEN is behind her.

JESSY Thank you very much Alex. You have successfully created a buzz.

NOAH

See.

JESSY hands ALEX a bag and an envelope.

JESSY Your payment.

> ALEX Thanks.

JESSY I have to go. Goodbye.

ALEX

Bye

JESSY leaves.

JEN Boy she doesn't like anyone she thinks is with Alex.

NOAH Really?

ALEX Jen!

JEN Serious, she shunned me earlier, and now she didn't even look at you.

> NOAH I noticed that.

ALEX That's just because I was here.

> JEN Pull your head in.

ALEX I'm not allowed to me modest.

> JEN Says who.

> > ALEX Noah.

JEN Well he needs to pull his head in too.

> NOAH Never.

ALEX I'm really hungry.

> NOAH Me too.

JEN We are in the city.

NOAH Lets find some food.

ALEX with his arm around NOAH, and JEN walk towards the road.

Outside the crowd DAVID approaches them.

DAVID is standing with approaching with his wife.

DAVID Mr Williams.

NOAH Here we go.

ALEX spins.

ALEX Yep?

DAVID Mr Alex Williams?

ALEX Yep.

DAVID I am David Campbell. Mr Jones.

NOAH nods.

ALEX

Yes?

DAVID I attended Saturday's match.

ALEX Sure?

DAVID I am CEO of the York Clash.

ALEX Oh. How can I help you?

DAVID I am supposed to meet you at tomorrow's training.

ALEX Yes, I heard someone was coming.

DAVID

As I said, I managed to catch the game on Saturday. You may have heard, the Clash are to enter the AFL this year.

> ALEX Yes, I'm looking forward to it.

DAVID Grant Hughes is, at present the team captain. As per his request, I have been seeking a co-captain.

ALEX

Ok.

DAVID

We have both been watching you very closely, and would like you to consider the role.

ALEX

No way. I havn't got the experience. University footy has nothing on national.

DAVID

In six years you have captained five teams, with six championships. You qualify.

ALEX

You may want to watch until this season ends. There have been, changes, this year.

DAVID

We are well aware of your relationship with Mr Jones. Mr Hughs tells me your game has improved.

NOAH Has he told you that inflicted injuries to Alex have also tripled?

DAVID No, I was not aware of that.

ALEX (to NOAH) It isn't a problem.

NOAH Most of it is coming from your own team.

DAVID

Nevertheless. I would like you to consider the position before tomorrow.

> ALEX Will do.

DAVID

If there is a problem with increasing injuries, a contract would protect you from that.

DAVID turns back to his wife

ALEX turns back towards the road.

After a few steps NOAH ducks under ALEX's arm,

NOAH One sec, wait here.

ALEX stands

NOAH trots off towards DAVID

NOAH

DAVID! Whatever Alex decides. If he gets hurt. You, will be keeping up with the Jones' legal staff.

DAVID chuckles.

DAVID

I will not let that happen.

NOAH I know Alex is good enough. But, if this is a publicity stunt... I'm sure I can find, or create, something that will be costly.

NOAH smiles.

NOAH (to WIFE) Lovely to see you again Georgia. Goodnight.

NOAH turns and runs back to ALEX.

NOAH gets back under ALEX'S arm.

ALEX What was that about?

NOAH I just had to threaten him. Make sure he knows you have a bodyguard.

ALEX Laughs.

ALEX Within my best interests?

NOAH

Always.

ALEX

Sounds good.

NOAH Food?

JEN I'm even hungry now. I really feel like hot chips.

ALEX Right then. Food, somewhere with hot chips.

THEY wait at the road until it is safe to cross.

FADE TO:

INT. JONES MANOR - DINING ROOM - MORNING

ALEX is reading a newspaper with his picture on the front.

ALEX is drinking milk from a large metal pitcher.

ALEX's mobile rings.

ALEX Hello?

JENNI MORRIS Mr Williams?

ALEX Yes?

> JENNI MORRIS Mr Williams, this is Jennifer Morris from Capri Management. I am calling in relation to your appearance last night.

ALEX Sure.

JENNI MORRIS Are you as yet represented?

ALEX No, I did the job last night for a friend.

> JENNI MORRIS It may interest you to know, I have received sixteen requests for your services this morning.

ALEX Really?

> JENNI MORRIS I am sure before long you will get several calls. I would like you to come to me with the highest offer you receive, and I will beat it. My offer at present, is 5 percent of all bookings, including a fifty thousand dollar retainer.

ALEX How did you get this number?

ALEX Oh.

JENNI MORRIS I approached Jessy Cartwright, after your appearance last night.

JENNI MORRIS

I apologise for the intrusion Mr Williams, however, as an agent I must seek each advantage.
